

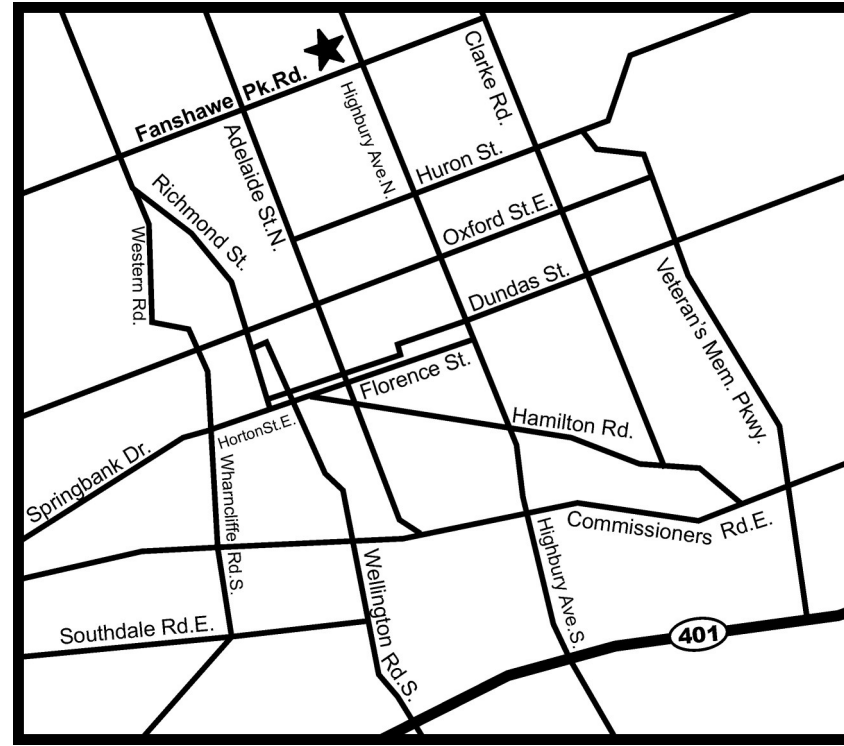

Please remember we are SCENT-FREE. Long-time participants will reconnect with old friends and make new ones. New “Eventers” will join to celebrate, laugh, sing, hug and go away refreshed, and planning for next year’s attendance.

REV. DR. DONNA KERRIGAN - was teaching in the Ontario Community Colleges System when she recognized the need in her home congregation for more intensive Christian Education. To address the need, she enrolled in some courses at Emmanuel College, and soon learned that God was calling her not into more teaching, but into ministry. Rev. Donna served at Burford United (2008-2016), and now serves with St. Andrew's United (St. Thomas). Her particular joy is the smaller congregation which “has a special calling, even in precarious times”. She recognizes that “smaller congregations can allow for active participation in worship by more lay members, and can also foster a multitude of pro-social activities”. “Outreach - beyond” is an important segment of Donna's ministry. She has taken part in dialogue on issues ranging from peace to the environment, seeking participation with Jewish, Muslim and Christian faith groups. In fact, Donna simply enjoys conversation with anyone about justice issues, peace-building, grandchildren, CBC-inspired topics, and recipes involving chocolate or maple syrup.

GLEN PEARSON- has been Executive Director of the London Food Bank for 30 years, serving as Chair of the Association of Ontario Food Banks for three years. For 18 years, Glen and his wife Jane Roy have directed the non-governmental organization, 'Canadian Aid for Sudan'. During that time, 10 primary schools and one high school were built and a number of programs for women were established. After retiring from a 30 year firefighting career, Glen was elected MP for London North Centre, serving in Ottawa from 2006-2011. He continues to act in numerous capacities in London and area, and lives happily with Jane and their 3 children adopted from South Sudan.

SOUP (Southern Ontario Ukulele Players) – began in 2009 with a small group of ukulele enthusiasts, and has swelled to over 300 members. Weekly, an average of 65 strummers ages 12-85 gather to enjoy their passion. For some, music has been a lifelong pursuit; for others, it's a new interest. Ukulele playing is NOT about being “perfect”; it's about sharing the joy of making music. Anyone can join SOUP. All that's needed is a ukulele in your hands and joy in your heart. Drop by the London Music Club at 7 PM any Wednesday evening. Beginner sessions are available on the first and third Weds. Cost is \$5.
