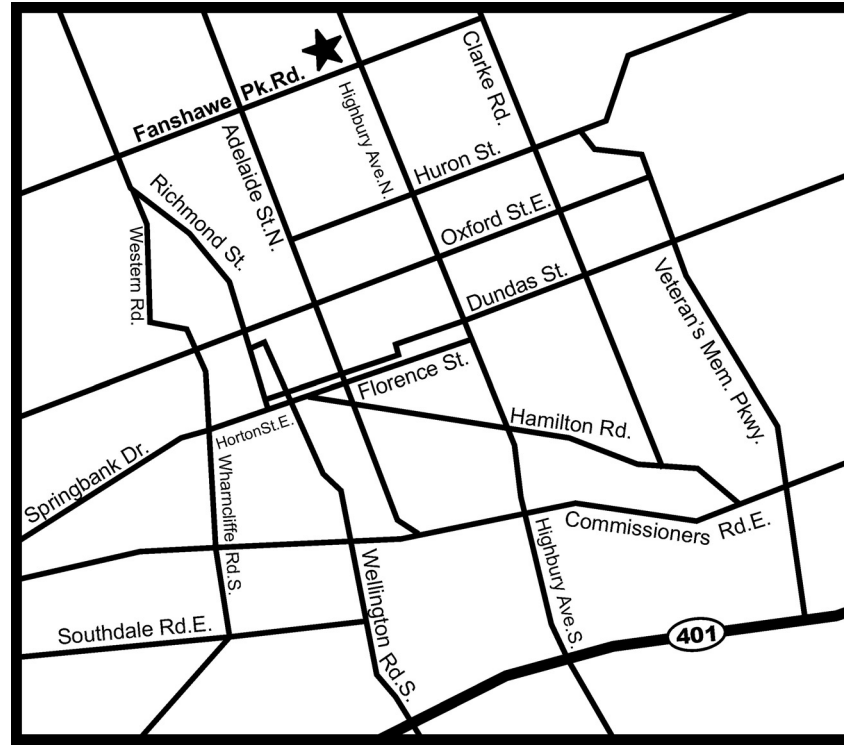

REV. JOAN GOLDEN—Born in Grey County a "farm girl" attending a one room elementary school. A mother of two and proud grandma of two boys, married to Rev. Richard Golden. Her first career was hospital and long-term care financial administration. In 1999, she began studies at the Centre of Christian Studies and was commissioned as a diaconal minister in 2005. She served in Brussels/Ethel pastoral charge 1999-2005, St. Andrew's in St. Thomas 2005-2015, and since July 2015, has been serving Oneida United Church and Moraviantown United Church. Both of these pastoral charges are part of Great Lakes Waterways Presbytery and the All Native Circle Conference within the United Church of Canada.

SUMMER THORP - Summer Thorp is the creator of and Program Coordinator for +Positive Voice, an award-winning and innovative program for urban Indigenous women who are in transition to education or employment. The program is located at Nokee Kwe, an organization that provides employment services and adult literacy services. In her previous role as an Employment Counsellor, she met with Indigenous women who frequently identified themselves as "just a mom" or "just a high school dropout." Through the +Positive Voice program, the participants are developing stories of strength, resilience, and accomplishment that they are sharing with each other and the community. Summer has always been interested in social justice and inter religious dialogue in her local community. She completed an Associate Degree in History, a BA in Social Justice and Peace Studies, and an MEd in Educational Studies, with a focus on Indigenous education. Public speaking comes easily to her and she has been teaching, speaking at conferences, and conducting workshops for women for 20 years.

WARRIOR WOMYN OF POSITIVE DRUM—A collaborative group of Warrior Womyn from different Nations, paths, and ages. We were brought together by the Positive Voice program at Nokee Kwe. With a common interest in wanting to learn our First nation songs, a group was formed. Together we learn and sing each other's songs using hand drums and water drums. We continue to learn and are excited with what the future has to offer with this sisterhood that has been formed. We have performed at community events for the London Public Library, the Museum of Ontario Archaeology, the Laubach Literacy Provincial Conference, and MP Irene Mathyssen's Canada 150 Award Celebration. Recently Positive Drum was nominated for a London music award in the world music category.
